CIRCULAR

The following protocol is to be followed for patients attending OPD services.

- 1. Thermal scanning at OPD entrance.
 - a). If temperature $> 98.4^{\circ}F$ then they are sent to Level -A
 - b). If temperature < 98. 4°F then they may proceed to MRD counter.
- 2. At MRD Counter, they are to submit the "Self-Declaration Checklist"
 - a). If any symptoms (fever, SARI, ILI) are noted in the Checklist then they will directed to Level-A for Screening.
 - b.) If no symptoms are declared they will be cleared to attend their respective OPD.
- 3. If the clinician at the OPD after history and examination feels that the patient is a COVID suspect they will refer the patient to Level-A, clearly recording their findings in the OPD Card.
