## NOTIFICATION

As recommended by the NEIGRIHMS College Council, the MBBS students of 3<sup>rd</sup> year 7<sup>th</sup> Semester are hereby notified to return to the Institute and report their presence between 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2020. It is advisable for the students to have the report of RTPCR testing for COVID-19 before coming to NEIGRIHMS, Shillong. Students arriving after the 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2020 will have to make their own arrangement for quarantine.

Students will have to undergo Institute quarantine for a period of 7 days after arrival and RTPCR test will be done on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of quarantine. Students on quarantine will have to pay for the food during quarantine period. If somebody does not want to avail NEIGRIHMS institutional quarantine facility, they may make their own arrangement with intimation to the Dean, NEIGRIHMS, and the Institute will not be responsible for their wellbeing in the facility where they put up.

Apart from the above mentioned students, others will not be housed in the Institute quarantine facility if they come without prior permission from NEIGRIHMS authority due to limited quarantine facility.

Students from within Meghalaya will undergo RTPCR test for COVID-19 on arrival.
