2 (two) posts reserved for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities in the non surgical departments as per Government of India policy:

Criteria of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities: One percent each reserved for persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (a), (b) and (c) and one percent for persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (d) and (e) namely:-

- a) Blindness and low vision;
- b) Deaf and hard of hearing;
- c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy,
- d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness;
- e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deafblindness in the posts indentified for each disabilities.

The disability certificate should be issued by a duly constituted ad authorized Medical Board of the State or Central Government Hospital/Institutions and countersigned by Medical Superintendent/CMO/Head of Hospital/Institution.

The Medical Board issuing certificate shall conform to guidelines of Ministry of Social Welfare and Empowerment (Govt. of India).

As per guidelines EWS posts are not carried forward/or Considered as backlog vacancy in case unfilled hence other category candidates may be allowed provisionally to apply for post subjected to condition that they will be considered for the post as an UR Candidate only if EWS category seat is otherwise not filled.

Educational qualification for the posts of Junior Resident Doctors:

- i. Medical qualification included in the Schedule I & II of the 3rd Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956 (persons possessing qualifications included in the part II of the 3rd schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in section 13 (B) of the Act).
- ii. Satisfactory completion of the compulsory internship.
- iii. Candidate must be registered with the Central/State Medical Council.

<u>Scale of Pay</u>: Level 10 of Pay Matrix with entry pay of Rs.56,100/- plus NPA and other allowances as admissible under rules.

Age limit – 30 years

The aspiring applicants satisfying the eligibility in all respect can submit their applications in prescribed proforma at **Annexure-I** alongwith scanned copy of the following self attested certificates by email to **neigrihms.recruitment@gmail.com.**

- ii. Certificate of Date of Birth (10th certificate)
- iii. Certificate of EWS/SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) certificate from the competent authority if applicable.
- iv. MBBS passed Certificate
- v. MBBS Marksheets
- vi. MBBS Attempt certificate
- vii. MBBS Internship Completion Certificate
- viii. Medical Registration Certificate for MBBS
- ix. NOC from the present employer (if employed)
- x. MCI/NMC Eligibility certificate for candidate(s) passing from foreign medical Institutions.
- xi. Result of screening test for Indian nationals with Foreign Medical Qualifications issued by the National Board of Examinations.

The documents submitted by the candidates will be screened before the interview and only the eligible candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria would be allowed to appear in the Interview.

The date of Interview will be published in the Institute's website.

The Candidates should bring the original documents at the time of interview at the Institute.

General Information:

- 1. Reservation for the above posts and age relaxation will be provided as per Govt. of India Norms. Age is relaxable upto 5 (five) years for SC/ST and 3(three) years for OBC (Noncreamy layer) candidates in respect of vacancies reserved for them. Age relaxation for physically handicapped candidates will be provided as per Govt. of India Norms.
- 2. Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) shall be applicable as per Govt. of India policy Office Memorandum No. 36039/1/2019-(Estt (Res) dated 19th January, 2019 and 31st January, 2019.
- 3. EWSs Candidates will have to attach certificate issued by the competent authority in the form prescribed as per Annexure-II.
- 4. Candidates belonging to OBC (NCL) category are required to produce the latest OBC (NCL) certificate issued by the Competent Authority during the current financial year i.e., 1.4.2025 to 31.3.2026.
- 5. If employed under the State or Central Govt. or PSU/Autonomous body, applicants are required to produce NOC from competent authority, failing which they will not be allowed to appear for interview under any circumstances.
- 6. Canvassing in any form will disqualify candidate.
- 7. Crucial date for determination of eligibility with regard to age, educational qualification and experience etc. will be the last date of submission of applications.
- 8. Physically handicapped candidates are required to produce the physically handicapped certificate (with degree of disability) in original issued by the Competent Authority (i.e. Medical Board duly constituted by the Central Govt. or State Govt.) at the time of interview.
- 9. Candidates are to ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility criteria. Candidates who do not fulfill any one of the above conditions, will not be allowed to appear in the interview.
- 10. Candidates who have been sponsored by the Govt. of Meghalaya for MBBS programme and having bond obligations will be governed by the Mandatory Medical Public Services Policy (MMPSC) issued by the Govt. of Meghalaya, department of H&FW vide Notification No.Health.231/2024/6-A dated 04.03.2025 in lieu of NOC.
- 11. Candidates who have been sponsored by the respective state governments for pursuing MBBS course and are required to undergo compulsory rural posting, if any. Such candidates will have to submit the certificate of completion of rural posting. They will be allowed provisionally to appear for interview subject to compliance of mandatory requirement.
- 12. Subject to availability, Resident Doctors will be provided accommodation in the RMO Hostel. In the event that no accommodation can be provided, HRA admissible as per rules will be paid.

- 13. Candidates who has completed the 1 (one) year tenure post as Junior Resident (house job) in State or Central Govt. or PSU/Autonomous bodies will not be allowed to appear in the interview under any circumstances.
- 14. Institute reserves the right to reject or accept any candidature without assigning any reason thereof.
- 15. No travelling allowance will be paid by this office for attending the interview.
- 16. The decision of the Institute as to eligibility or otherwise of a candidate will be final.
