Local content = (Sale price - Value of imported content) * 100/ Sale price

Where, "Sale price" means price excluding net domestic indirect taxes an d "Value of

imported content" means price of imported content inclusive of all custo ms duties

Question2. How to calculate Local Content in bids involving supply of mult iple items from single bidder?
